Electricity: The electrical supply is 200-220 volts.

Climate: In Lagos, August is a raining season and you could look forward to temperature of $25 - 28^{\circ}$ C during the day and much less at night. Raincoats may be useful.

Shopping:

Shops open from 7.00a.m to 6.00p.m with late night shopping for open market. A shopping mall (CITY MALL) is close to the venue of the conference

Transport from Airport

Abstracts should contain materials not published before or presented elsewhere prior to August 8, 2006. The abstracts should be structured as follows: Name of Author(s); Address or Affiliation; Background of Study; Objectives; Methodology; Results; Discussion and Conclusions. Each Abstract should not exceed 250 words and should be typed double-spaced with font size 11 or 12. The name of the presenting author should be underlined. Provision of English or French translation of the Abstract (as appropriate) if included will be appreciated.

Kindly specify whether Oral Presentation or Poster and the Theme preferred. Abstracts should be sent electronically to Prof. Tayo Sokunbi, Chairman, Scientific Committee (e-mail addresses:paans2006@yahoo.com, tayosokunbi@yahoo.com)) and an acknowledgement would be sent within three days of receipt.

Accepted abstracts of those who registered for the Congress will be published in the Book of Proceedings of the Congress and on CD-ROM. A copy of the abstract book and CD ROM will be given to all delegates who register / attend the conference
